### **Year 11 Mock Exams November 2020**

As part of the preparation of Year 11 students for their GCSEs next summer, we are holding some informal Year 11 mock exams starting on Tuesday 4 November. They are scheduled over three weeks so as not to overload your child. The first week will be core exams, maths, English and science, followed by their option subjects during week commencing 9 November.

These mock exams are going to be held in the classroom and will be an opportunity for teachers to assess where your child is in their learning. Most subjects will be only one exam paper and only one or two lessons in order to preserve as much teaching time as possible.

In February we are planning to run more formal mocks in the Sports Hall to give your child an opportunity to familiarise themselves with how they will run in the summer.


Please find enclosed a timetable for your information, detailing which subject exams are on which days. The timetable will also be posted on Satchel One.
