Club Name	Description
Anime club	Watching interesting anime and talk about it with other fans
Board Games Club	Come along and pit your wits against your friends and make some new friends. Games include Draughts, Othello and Who Wants to Be a Millionaire
Charity Club	Helping to raise money for charities and good causes and have lots of fun in the process.
