

## **Aldworth School: Provider Access Policy.**

### **Introduction:**

This policy statement sets out the school's arrangements for managing the access of providers to pupils at the school for the purpose of giving them information about the provider's education or training offer. This complies with the school's legal obligations under Section 42B of the Education Act 1997

### **Pupil entitlement:**

All pupils in years 7-13 are entitled:

- to find out about technical education qualifications and apprenticeship opportunities, as part of a careers programme which provides information on the full range of education and training options available at each transition point;
- to hear from a range of local providers about the opportunities they offer, including technical education and apprenticeships – through options events, assemblies and group discussions and taster events;
- to have two encounters with the local providers in KS3 and two encounters in KS4. These provided encounters will all have the opportunity for the students to ask questions.
- to understand how to make applications for the full range of academic and technical courses.

- **Opportunities for Access**

The school offers the six provider encounters required by law and a number of additional events, integrated into the school careers programme. We will offer providers an opportunity to come into school to speak to pupils or their parents or carers. These include World of Work Days, PSHE Career Units, Enterprise Challenges, Apprenticeship Events during National Apprenticeship Week, Year 11 Future Options Assemblies and Year 9 Options Evening. A detailed updated programme will be outlined on the school website every Autumn Term. We are open to these encounters being face to face or live online engagement with our pupils.

- **Premises and Facilities**

The School will make the Main Hall, classrooms, or private meeting rooms available for discussions between the provider and students, as appropriate to the activity. The School will also make available AV and other specialist equipment to support provider presentations. This will all be discussed and agreed in advance of the visit with the Careers Leader or a member of the School team. Providers are welcome to leave copies of their prospectus or other relevant course literature to be made available through the Learning Resource Centre.

- **Complaints:**

Any complaints with regards to provider access can be raised following the school complaints procedure.
