Online payments - SCOPAY



- Download app (or use via website)
- Log in details on letter
- Can be used to pay for trips, music lessons, lockers, equipment, revision guides and canteen top ups
- Can set up low balance alerts for canteen

Canteen

- Biometric consent for fingerprint
- Fingerprint registration first day 5 Sep
- Free school meals £2.80
- Food choices – meal deal best value
- Top up account £5 minimum please / no overdraft so top up regularly (can set low balance alert).
- Free cereal 8am to 8.30am

School Trips

- Annual medical form issued in September to cover day trips or off site activities.
- Residentials we will always request new form.
- Trip letter issued – will ask for consent to be given on SCO and if able to pay contribution.

School Books

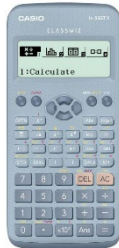
You will need to check your timetable to make sure you bring the correct books.
